It is with great pleasure that WEEVA partners with Mastergraphics for 2008 again to award student scholarships for your Supermileage and Electrathon members pursuing post-secondary education in a technological career! Through Mastergraphics partnership of \$10,000.00 towards student scholarships, WEEVA will be splitting this up in two formats, similar to 2007. 1) Overall "Event" Championship Scholarships: \$1,500.00 each

There will be five teams this year receiving \$1,500.00 in student scholarships through their participation and achievement of the Overall "Event" Championship Award. This award is given to a participating team at three WEEVA events, where the team excels in all categories of trial, including; mileage/endurance, paperwork, car show, braking, maneuverability, and others. The winning teams of this scholarship will decide a minimum of four (4) members to split the funds with, at which time they graduate and show proof of enrollment in a post-secondary degree program with the emphasis of a Technological Career, they may receive their funds from WEEVA. This scholarship is eligible to any participating Wisconsin Team member in Supermileage or Electrathon. Breakdowns are as follows.

2) Competitive Educational Scholarships: (2) \$500.00 & (3) \$300.00

There will be five (5) competitive scholarships available to current seniors participating in local Wisconsin Supermileage or Wisconsin Electrathon teams this year. These will be by process of application, chosen by members of the WEEVA Board of Directors. Eligibility is current Seniors (that have participated in Supermileage or Electrathon) enrolling in 2 year or 4 year colleges with emphasis in Technological Degrees. Application Process includes: an application, a short essay, HS transcripts and attendance records and two (2) letters of recommendation. The deadline for these applications is June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008.
